## The Clinic and Services

**Suitable Patient:** Elevated PSA. Abnormal/Hard DRE on examination.

**Referrals:** Consultant triage.

**Appointments:** Centralised administration team coordinates scheduling of all appointments and follow up care with patient.

**Reports:** Direct to referring doctor. Urgent results followed up verbally.

**Insurance - TRUS biopsy:** Day case full-cover on most plans.

**Consultation & Assessment:** €200 payable on the day of appointment
