You should ensure that you have the following up to date items at hand in case of an emergency.

\square Copy of medication list
☐ Copy of medical history
☐ Insurance / policy number (if applicable)
☐ List of allergies (if applicable)
\Box First aid kit (check the expiration date of the items 1 to 2 times per year)
☐ Gauze or dressings (different sizes)
☐ Wound plasters/adhesives (different sizes)
☐ Elastic bandages
\square Ice pack
☐ Microporous (medical) tape
☐ Scissors
☐ Tweezers
☐ Burn gels
☐ Wound cleanser (wipes or pads)
☐ Triangular bandage
☐ Pair of gloves
\square Over the counter medications
☐ Paracetamol
☐ Ibuprofen
